

CHANGE OF HEART AND MIND

“My relationship isn’t very stable,” 35-year-old Nadia told our Nurse. “He doesn’t even think he’s the father. I don’t know what I’ll do if he’s not supportive – I don’t want to be a single mom.” Our patient had lost her job and was undecided as to the outcome of her pregnancy. With a positive pregnancy test Nadia was given an ultrasound. The image of her nearly six-week-old appeared on the screen. The Nurse pointed out the heartbeat, and a small smile came to Nadia’s face.

The Nurse reviewed our patient’s pregnancy options. As they discussed abortion, Nadia said, “Seeing the heartbeat, I can’t see myself doing that now. I actually feel somewhat excited.” Our Nurse also went over the options of adoption and parenting and told Nadia about our Resource Program as well as provided her with a listing of community resources. “I plan to continue the pregnancy,” Nadia said afterward. “Knowing there are resources out there to help me makes me feel better about

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things. If the father of my child isn’t on board, I’ll consider adoption as it might be best for the baby. But, I won’t have an abortion, and I will look into the resources you’ve given me.”

Before Nadia left the Center, she and the Nurse talked about faith. “I consider myself a Buddhist, but I have been going to church with my aunt lately. I’m interested in exploring Christianity, and I know about Jesus, but I’m not ready to make a commitment just yet,” Nadia said. The Nurse encouraged her to continue attending and to read the Bible and the brochure she was sending home with her. Nadia agreed to do so.

When the Nurse contacted our patient the following week for STD results, Nadia reaffirmed she planned to continue her pregnancy and had made an appointment with a local physician. “Thank you for all you’ve done for me, for the ultrasound image and the resource list and for encouraging me to explore the Christian faith more,” Nadia said. “I’m feeling good about where my life is going now. I’m excited!”

2019 Annual Progress Report


HERE'S WHAT WE ACCOMPLISHED IN 2019:

1. Two-hundred thirty-four unborn babies were saved.
2. The Gospel was presented more than 175 times.
3. Eighty-nine new people were introduced to our life-saving work by attending a Vision Tour, a one-hour tour of True Care from the patient's perspective.

5. Added more evening appointments to better accommodate test patients and those enrolled in our educational programs who are only available after school or in the evening.
6. Hired a new nurse, Megan Boomgarden, and trained her in limited obstetrical ultrasound.

LOOKING FORWARD

1. Abortion Pill Reversal. As of January 2020, we will offer abortion pill reversal to women who have started a chemical abortion and have changed their minds.
2. We will continue to refer our single, pregnant patients to, Embrace Grace. This is a partnership with two local churches to provide encouragement, love and support. 3. Digital, digital, digital: the majority of our marketing will be on social media networks as we strive to be relevant to and reach our target audience—abortion-minded and abortion-determined women. We added Google Ads and YouTube to the mix this year.


